Westfield Group UK Ltd, works with the removal and encapsulation of asbestos from premises. For this industry there are regulatory controls imposed by the Control of Asbestos at Work Regulations, The Asbestos (Licensing) Regulations and the various regulations covering the transport and disposal of hazardous materials. These regulations are supported by guidance documents and approved codes of practice. Their main purpose is the protection of the public from the hazards posed by inhaling asbestos fibre and the spread of asbestos fibre into the environment.

Protection of employees, the public and the environment is paramount in all aspects of the Company's operations. The Company's obligations are met through the method statements, risk assessments and work instructions that are prepared for each job to cover the range of Company activities, the training provided and the determination of future training needs.

Senior management provides a positive lead in promoting protection of staff, the public and the environment. In addition, all employees are under an obligation to co-operate fully with management in the effective implementation of this policy.
